



## **FiSH IS LOOKING FOR NEW TRUSTEES BE A GOOD NEIGHBOUR - APPLY TO JOIN ITS BOARD OF CHARITY TRUSTEES**

FiSH Neighbourhood Care, a highly regarded local charity, is looking to recruit up to two new trustees to join its Board of Trustees in overseeing and developing its work in Barnes, Mortlake and East Sheen supporting older and more vulnerable people by combating loneliness and social isolation, and connecting communities. Applicants would ideally have career experience in the provision of medical care in the community or of care at home for the elderly or a background in accounting control and financial reporting (with a view to him/her becoming Treasurer in late 2019). Due to the current makeup of the Board, applications from women and persons resident in Barnes who have the relevant skills and experience are particularly welcome. Appointments will commence on 23 July 2018 and will be for a term of three years, with the possibility of reappointment for a further term of three years. Do you think you could be a trustee or do you know someone who you think would make a key contribution and who you can encourage to apply? If so, apply now yourself or speak to the person you know.

The Board's policy is to have between eight and twelve Trustees. Currently there are ten Trustees. The proposed appointments are part of the regular refreshment of the Board of Trustees. Appointments are made by the members of FiSH at the AGM in July 2018; FiSH is a company limited by guarantee. Trustees meet regularly: there are usually five early evening Board meetings each year and each Trustee usually sits on one Board committee which also meets several times a year and assists FiSH staff with matters within the Trustee's area of expertise. Trustees are not remunerated. Short listed candidates will have a chance to meet some of the Trustees and the Director.

FiSH provides quality activities, events, services and support, finding innovative and creative ways of meeting the increasing needs amongst older people, delivering regular events and activities to combat social isolation, loneliness and connect communities. FiSH has a small staff and currently over 300 volunteers, recruited, trained, encouraged and supported by FiSH who help to deliver the activities, events and services that are on offer.
